AFFIDAVIT

STATE OF IOWA Madison County)SS:

I, Rex V. Johnson of Madison County, Iowa, first being duly sworn on oath depose and say:
That I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa for more than Twenty-five (25) years
last past, and that during said period of time I have been acquainted with the ownership
and legal title to the following described real estate, to-wit:

The South 49½ feet of Lot Two (2) and the
North 53 feet of Lot Three (3) in Block
Three (3) of Atkinson's First Addition to
the Town of Truro, Madison County, Iowa.

That I have also been personally acquainted with F. D. Mason and E. N. Mason, who
became the holders of the legal title to said real estate in a Warranty Deed filed for record
in Town Lot Deed Record 22, on Page 655 of the records of the County Recorder of Madison County,
Iowa.

That F. D. Mason died on or about January 4, 1932, leaving surviving him E. N. Mason his
surviving spouse.

That the said E. N. Mason has never received assistance from the Division of Old Age
Assistance, State Department of Social Welfare of the State of Iowa, and that the lien for
assistance dated March 22, 1940, filed March 28, 1940 in Old Age Pension Record 2, on Page
190 of the records of the County Recorder of Madison County, Iowa against Elizabeth Mason is
not a lien against, or does not refer to E. N. Mason.

That the E. N. Mason, the present owner of the above described real estate and Elizabeth
Mason against whom the lien for assistance above referred to is filed are not one and the
same identical person, but are two different individuals.

That E. N. Mason resides at the present time in the State of Illinois, and that Elizabeth
Mason is a resident of Spirit Lake, Dickinson County, Iowa.

That I have no personal interest in the real estate hereinbefore described, or in any
manner in connection herewith, but that I make this affidavit for the purpose of establish-
ing the facts as true as herein stated.
