AFFIDAVIT

State of Iowa, County of Madison.)ss:

I, W. P. Bengé, of said county and state, being first duly sworn on oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than 50 years last past, and am well and personally acquainted with the persons hereinafter named.

That I was personally acquainted with A. J. Adkison who died in Madison County, Iowa, on or about December, 1894, and know that his wife, Anner Adkison, mentioned in his last will and testament, died prior to the death of her said husband, A. J. Adkison.

That the G. S. McMillan mentioned in the last will and testament of said A. J. Adkison, is the same person as the Orpha S. Adkison and the same person as Orpha Adkison, mentioned in various places in the proceedings in the estate of said A. J. Adkison.

That the house and lot bequeathed to Eudora Bengé in the codicil to the last will and testament of said A. J. Adkison, deceased, and described as being at the Southeast corner of a block in Jones' addition to the city of Winterset, Iowa, occupied by Joe Shannon and family, was not intended to be Lot 5 in Block 9 of Laughridge & Cassidy's Addition to Winterset, Iowa.

That said Eudora Bengé was my Mother.
