That she is a resident of Madison County, Iowa; that she is a daughter of the Henry G. Leveke who was a son and a devisee of the Henry Leveke who died testate on or about Nov. 8, 1918, seized of Lot 1 and the North 110 feet of the East 41 feet of Lot 2, in Block 3, of Pitzer & Knight's Addition to the Original Town of Winterset, Iowa, and a niece of the Amelia M.
