duly sworn on oath depose and say that I am the same and identical person as the Harry H. Hodgson named in the last will and testament of my father Newton Hodgson, deceased, and who acted as executor in the administration of said estate in the District Court of Polk County, Iowa, and that I am familiar with the land located in Madison County, Iowa, which was owned by my said father, Newton Hodgson, at the time of his death, and know that it consisted of a farm of 360 acres and is described as the $\frac{W}{2}$ of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ and the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of the $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5 and the $E\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, in Township 74 North, Range 26 West of the 5th P.M., Madison County, Iowa.

I further state that I am informed that the above mentioned last will and testament describes a part of the above described land as the $E\frac{1}{2}$ and the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, and also that said land is so described in other proceedings in said estate, viz: in the probate inventory, the final report, and the order approving final report, all as shown by the probate records in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of Polk County, Iowa, a transcript of which has been filed and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of Madison County, Iowa; and I further state that it was my intention, and also the intention of the attorney who prepared the original papers filed in said estate proceedings, to include all of the land in Madison County, Iowa, which was owned by my said father at the time of his death, and that the said land located in said Section 8 should have been, and was intended to include the $E\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, being in area 200 acres in Section 8, in addition to the 160 acres in Section 5 above described, all in the said Township 74 North, Range 26 West of the 5th P.M.; and that I make these statements from my personal knowledge of the facts and to correct an apparent error in the description of said real estate.
