We, the undersigned members of Earlham Monthly Meeting of Friends Church of Earlham, Madison County, Iowa, do adopt the following Renewal of Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this body is Earlham Monthly Meeting of Friends Church by which name it shall acquire and hold property, real, personal, and mixed, sue and be sued; defend and be defended, and adopt a Common Seal, and alter the same at pleasure.

ARTICLE II. MEETING

The regular business meetings of this body shall be held at Earlham, Iowa, the third Seventh Day of each month at two o'clock P.M., and at such other times as said body in regular session assembled shall direct.

ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP

The members of this body shall consist of the persons whose names appear upon the Membership list of Earlham Monthly Meeting of Friends Church of Earlham, Madison County, Iowa, an unincorporated body which by these presents merges into Earlham Monthly Meeting of Friends Church, a corporation as therein described, together with such persons as may be received into membership from time to time under the rules prescribed in the discipline of Iowa Yearly Meeting of Friends Church.

ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS

The Officers of this body and the duties of the same shall be such as are provided for in the discipline of Iowa Yearly Meeting of Friends Church as far as the instruction of said discipline is is applicable to monthly meetings.

ARTICLE V. DEBTS.

The private property of members of this body shall not be liable for Corporate debts.

ARTICLE VI. AMENDMENTS.

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended or repealed at any regular business meeting, three months notice in writing having first been given.

ARTICLE VII. GOVERNMENT

In all cases of Government and procedure not otherwise provided for, the discipline of Iowa Yearly Meeting of Friends Church shall govern.
