IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the United States of America has caused these presents to be executed by its duly authorized representative this 2 day of January, 1948.

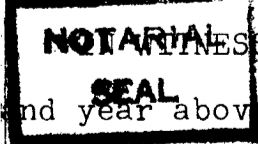
