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Seventh Supplemental Indenture

DATED AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 1960

(SUPPLEMENTAL TO INDENTURE DATED AS OF
NOVEMBER 1, 1945)

(This instrument contains after acquired property provisions; also, this instrument is filed as a Chattel Mortgage in Oklahoma and is not required to be refiled under the provisions of Section 61, Title 46, Oklahoma Statutes, 1951.)

(This Instrument contains after acquired property provisions.)

This Seventh Supplemental Indenture, dated as of September 1, 1960, between **NATURAL GAS PIPELINE COMPANY OF AMERICA**, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware (hereinafter called the "Company"), party of the first part, and **THE CHASE MANHATTAN BANK**, New York, New York (successor by merger to The Chase National Bank of the City of New York), a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York and having its principal place of business in the City of New York, and **MERCANTILE TRUST COMPANY**, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri and having its principal place of business in the City of St. Louis, Missouri (hereinafter called, respectively, the "Trustee", and the "Missouri Trustee" and together called the "Trustees"), as Trustees, parties of the second part, WITNESSETH that:

WHEREAS, in order to secure First Mortgage Pipeline and Collateral Trust Bonds and First Mortgage Pipeline Bonds of the Company, issuable in series, the Company has heretofore made, executed and delivered its certain Indenture of Mortgage and Deed of Trust dated as of November 1, 1945 (hereinafter sometimes called the "Original Indenture") to The Chase National Bank of the City of New York, as Trustee, and indentures supplemental thereto dated, respectively, as of July 1, 1946, as of June 1, 1948, as of December 1, 1950, and as of December 30, 1950, and thereafter has made, executed and delivered other indentures supplemental to its said Original Indenture to The Chase Manhattan Bank (successor by merger to The Chase National Bank of the City of New York) as Trustee as aforesaid, dated, respectively, as of November 1, 1958, and as of April 1, 1959 (said Original Indenture, said Supplemental Indentures dated, respectively, as of July 1, 1946, as of June 1, 1948, as of December 1, 1950, as of December 30, 1950, as of November 1, 1958, and as of April 1, 1959, being hereinafter collectively called the "Original Indenture, as amended", and said Original Indenture, as amended, as supplemented and amended by this Seventh Supplemental Indenture being hereinafter collectively called the "Indenture"); and

WHEREAS, there have heretofore been issued under the Original Indenture, as amended, and there are outstanding on September 1, 1960, First

Mortgage Pipeline and Collateral Trust Bonds and First Mortgage Pipeline Bonds of five several series in the following respective principal amounts:

WHEREAS, Peoples Gulf Coast Natural Gas Pipeline Company, a Delaware corporation (hereinafter sometimes called "Gulf Coast"), pursuant to a plan of reorganization, has been dissolved and liquidated and in connection therewith the Company has acquired all of the assets and properties, subject to the debts and liabilities, of Gulf Coast; and

WHEREAS, in order to conform to the legal requirements of the State of Missouri, the Company and the Trustee, pursuant to authority granted in the Original Indenture, as amended, have heretofore executed an Instrument of Appointment under which Mercantile Trust Company has been appointed the Missouri Trustee with such powers, rights and duties and with such limitations as are specified in said Instrument of Appointment; and

WHEREAS, this Seventh Supplemental Indenture is executed and delivered for the purpose of confirming and perfecting the lien of the Indenture (i) upon properties acquired by the Company from Gulf Coast, as aforesaid (except property of the character embraced within the definition of Excepted Property as set forth in the Indenture), so that the lien of the Indenture may be confirmed of record in each of the counties and other jurisdictions in which the properties so acquired from Gulf Coast are located and (ii) upon properties heretofore acquired by the Company and now subject to the lien of the Original Indenture, as amended, but not heretofore specifically described therein; and

WHEREAS, the execution and delivery by the Company and the Trustees of a supplemental indenture for the purposes of this Seventh Supplemental Indenture is authorized by the provisions of Section 163 of the Original Indenture; and

WHEREAS, the Company by appropriate corporate action has duly authorized the execution of this Seventh Supplemental Indenture for the various purposes herein set forth, and all of the conditions and requirements necessary to make this Seventh Supplemental Indenture a valid, binding and legal instrument in accordance with its terms have been done, performed and fulfilled, and the execution and delivery hereof have been in all respects duly authorized;

Now, THEREFORE, in order further to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on all Bonds at any time issued and outstanding under the Indenture, according to their tenor, purport and effect, and to secure the performance and observance of all the covenants and conditions therein and in the Indenture contained, and for and in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants herein contained, and of the sum of \$1 duly paid to the Company by the Trustees at or before the ensealing and delivery hereof, and for other valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the Company has executed and delivered this Seventh Supplemental Indenture, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, release, convey, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, set over and confirm and warrant unto the Trustees, the property, rights, privileges and franchises hereinafter described (other than property of the character embraced within such definition of Excepted Property), which, collectively, together with such of the properties, rights, privileges and franchises as are described in the Original Indenture and in indentures supplemental thereto heretofore executed and delivered and are owned by the Company on the date of the delivery hereof (other than property of the character embraced within such definition of Excepted Property), the conveyance of which is expressly confirmed, are hereinafter called the "Trust Estate," and the Trustee does hereby consent to and confirm the conveyance hereby made of said Trust Estate to the Missouri Trustee, all as follows:

DIVISION I—PROPERTIES ACQUIRED FROM GULF COAST

All of the property, real, personal and mixed, tangible and intangible (other than property of the character embraced within such definition of

Excepted Property), acquired by the Company from Gulf Coast, including, without limitation as to the generality of the foregoing, (i) all properties, rights and interests included within the specific and general descriptions set forth in that certain Indenture of Mortgage and Deed of Trust dated as of September 1, 1950, made, executed and delivered by Texas Illinois Natural Gas Pipeline Company, a Delaware corporation (herein sometimes called "Texas Illinois"), to The First National Bank of Chicago and Mississippi Valley Trust Company, as Trustees (hereinafter sometimes called the "Original Gulf Coast Mortgage"), and in the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Supplemental Indentures thereto, except properties heretofore specifically released from the lien thereof (Gulf Coast being the successor corporation to Texas Illinois under the terms of said Original Gulf Coast Mortgage, as amended and supplemented), said Original Gulf Coast Mortgage and said Supplemental Indentures having been recorded in the deed, deed of trust or real estate mortgage records of various counties in the States of Arkansas, Illinois, Missouri, and Texas, and in the chattel mortgage records of various counties in the States of Missouri and Texas as set forth below in Part A of the Description of Property Acquired From Gulf Coast and reference is hereby made to such deed, deed of trust or real estate mortgage records and chattel mortgage records and to the respective instruments so recorded for a more particular description of such properties, rights and interests so included herein and said descriptions are hereby incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof as effectively as if fully set out herein; and (ii) all properties, rights and interests described in Part B of said Description of Property Acquired From Gulf Coast, being properties not specifically described in the said Original Gulf Coast Mortgage or in the said First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Supplemental Indentures thereto, all as follows:

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY ACQUIRED FROM GULF COAST

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TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the properties, estates, rights, privileges and franchises hereby mortgaged, conveyed, pledged or assigned or intended so to be by the Original Indenture, as amended, and this Seventh Supplemental Indenture, together with all the appurtenances thereunto appertaining, unto the Trustees and their successors and assigns forever;

Subject, however, to the reservations, exceptions, limitations and restrictions contained in the several deeds, leases, servitudes, contracts or other instruments through which Gulf Coast or the Company acquired and/or claims title to and/or enjoys the use of the mortgaged properties; and *subject also* to such servitudes, easements, rights and privileges in, over, on and/or through said properties as have been granted by Texas Illinois, Gulf Coast or by the Company to other persons prior to the delivery of this Seventh Supplemental Indenture; and *subject also* to easements for streets, alleys, highways, railroad purposes and other rights-of-way on, over or under the mortgaged property; and *subject also* to Permitted Encumbrances (as defined in the Indenture), and, as to any property hereafter acquired by the Company, to any liens thereon existing, and to any liens for unpaid portions of the purchase money placed thereon at the time of such acquisition, but only to the extent that such liens are permitted by the Indenture, and *subject also*, with respect to the conveyance made to the Missouri Trustee of the Trust Estate, to the provisions contained in the Indenture and in said Instrument of Appointment,

IN TRUST, NEVERTHELESS, upon the terms and trusts in the Original Indenture, as amended, and in this Seventh Supplemental Indenture set forth, for the equal and proportionate use, benefit, security and protection of those who from time to time shall hold the Bonds and coupons authenticated and delivered under the Original Indenture, as amended, and as amended and supplemented by this Seventh Supplemental Indenture and as may hereafter be further amended and supplemented, and duly issued by the Company, without any discrimination, preference or priority of any Bond or coupon over any other by reason of priority in the time of issue, sale or negotiation thereof or otherwise except as provided in the Indenture, so that, subject to said provisions, each and all of the said Bonds and coupons shall have the same right, lien and privilege under the Original Indenture, and any indenture supplemental thereto and shall be equally secured thereby (except as any sinking, amortization, improvement, renewal or other fund established in accordance with the provisions of the Original

Indenture or any indenture supplemental thereto may afford additional security for the Bonds of any particular series), and in trust for enforcing payment of the principal of the Bonds and of the interest thereon according to the tenor, purport and effect of the Bonds and coupons and of the Indenture, and for enforcing the terms, provisions, covenants and stipulations in the Original Indenture, as amended, and in this Seventh Supplemental Indenture and in the Bonds set forth.

UPON CONDITION that, until the happening of an Event of Default (as defined in Section 121 of Article Thirteen of the Original Indenture), the Company shall be suffered and permitted to possess, use and enjoy the property, estates, rights, privileges and franchises conveyed by said Original Indenture, as amended, and by this Seventh Supplemental Indenture, except as limited in respect of money, securities and other personal property pledged or deposited with, or required to be pledged or deposited with, the Trustees or either of them hereunder, and to receive and use the rents, issues, income, revenues, earnings and profits therefrom.

ARTICLE ONE

Amendments to the Original Indenture, as Amended.

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Article One of the Original Indenture is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subdivision Q., as follows:

“Q. The term “Missouri Trustee” shall mean an additional or separate or co-trustee appointed pursuant to the provisions of Section 160 for the reasons set forth in and meeting the requirements of Section 159A and shall include the Mercantile Trust Company, St. Louis, Missouri, a corporation which has become such additional or separate or co-trustee pursuant to said Sections, as well as any successor additional or separate or co-trustee who shall become successor to the Missouri Trustee in the manner prescribed in this Indenture.”

SECTION 2. Section 157 of Article Sixteen of the Original Indenture is hereby amended by adding a new paragraph at the end thereof as follows:

“If an additional or separate or co-trustee is appointed pursuant to Section 160, the provisions of this Section which are specifically applicable to the Trustee shall also apply to such additional or separate or co-trustee.”

SECTION 3. Article Sixteen of the Original Indenture, as heretofore amended, is further amended by adding thereto three new sections designated as Sections 159A, 159B and 159C, as follows:

"SECTION 159A. If and so long as any of the mortgaged property shall be located in the State of Missouri and for that reason or any other reason the Company is required by law to name a domestic corporation or a resident of that state as co-trustee, then, there shall be, in addition to the Trustee hereunder, an additional or separate or co-trustee which is organized as a corporation under the laws of the State of Missouri and has its principal office in Kansas City or St. Louis, Missouri, and is subject to supervision or examination by state authority, and has a combined capital and surplus of not less than \$200,000."

"SECTION 159B. In case of any release of property or any advance by the Missouri Trustee or by an additional or separate or co-trustee which the Trustee would be required to report pursuant to the provisions of Subsection (b) of Section 159, such Missouri Trustee, or such additional or separate or co-trustee shall, within 60 days after such release or such advance shall have been made, furnish to the Trustee in writing all information necessary to enable the Trustee to make the required report regarding such release or such advance.

"As set forth in Section 160, the Company and the Trustee, at any time by an instrument in writing executed by them jointly, may accept the resignation of or remove the Missouri Trustee or any additional or separate or co-trustee, and, upon the request of the Trustee, the Company shall, for such purpose, join with the Trustee in the execution, delivery and performance of all instruments and agreements necessary or proper to make effective such resignation or removal; *provided, however*, that so long as a Missouri Trustee is required to act hereunder in order to conform to any legal requirements, of any jurisdiction, the resignation or removal of such Missouri Trustee shall not be effective unless and until a successor Missouri Trustee has been appointed. In the event that the Company shall not have joined in such action within 15 days after the receipt by it of a request to do so, the Trustee alone shall have power to accept such resignation or to remove any such Missouri Trustee or any additional or separate or co-trustee, and the Trustee, without the concurrence of the Company, shall have the power to appoint a successor to the Missouri Trustee or an additional or separate or co-trustee so resigned or removed.

"In case the Missouri Trustee or any additional or separate or co-trustee, or a successor to any of them, shall die, resign, or be removed,

or shall otherwise become incapable of acting or cease to be a trustee hereunder, all the estates, properties, rights, powers, trusts, duties and obligations of the Trustees so retiring hereunder, so far as permitted by law, shall vest in and be exercised by the Trustee, or its successor in the trust hereunder, unless prior to such resignation, removal or cessation to act a successor Missouri Trustee or a successor additional or separate or co-trustee has been appointed.”

“SECTION 159C. The Missouri Trustee and every additional or separate or co-trustee appointed hereunder shall, to the extent permitted by law, but to such extent only, be deemed to be appointed subject to the following terms and conditions:

“(1) The Bonds secured hereby shall be authenticated and delivered solely by the Trustee, or its successor in the trust hereunder;

“(2) All cash collected by or payable to the Trustee or the Missouri Trustee or an additional, or separate or co-trustee or any of them pursuant to this Indenture shall be paid to and deposited with the Trustee, and all stocks, bonds and other securities received by the Trustee or the Missouri Trustee or an additional, or separate or co-trustee or any of them pursuant to this Indenture shall be delivered to and held by the Trustee, except as otherwise required by law, and the rights, powers and duties with respect to the administration, management and disposition thereof, including the rights, powers and duties vested in the Trustee under this Indenture, shall not vest in the Missouri Trustee or in any additional or separate or co-trustee, but shall remain vested solely in the Trustee hereunder;

“(3) No powers shall be exercised hereunder by the Missouri Trustee or by any additional or separate or co-trustee, except jointly with, or with the consent in writing of, the Trustee; *provided, however*, that if by any present or future law in any jurisdiction in which it may be necessary to perform any particular act or acts in the execution of the trusts herein created, the Trustee shall be incompetent or unqualified to perform such act or acts, then, to such extent as may be legally necessary, all of the acts required to be performed in such jurisdiction in the execution of the trusts hereby created shall be performed by the Missouri Trustee or by any such additional or separate or co-trustee, acting alone;

“(4) Any notice, request or other writing by or in behalf of the Bondholders delivered solely to the Trustee, or its successor in the trust hereunder, shall be deemed delivered to all the then trustees hereunder as effectually as if delivered to each of them; and

“(5) Any action authorized to be taken by the Trustee under any provisions of this Indenture shall be sufficient for the purposes of this Indenture if taken by the Trustee alone; and any action authorized to be taken by the Trustee or by the Missouri Trustee or any additional or separate or co-trustee under any provision of this Indenture shall also, subject to the proviso contained in Subsection (3) of this Section, be sufficient for the purposes of this Indenture if taken by the Trustee alone, and the Missouri Trustee, and every additional or separate or co-trustee hereby irrevocably constitutes and appoints the Trustee, or its successor in the trust hereunder, his or its true and lawful agent or attorney in fact, with full power and authority, to the extent which may be permitted by law, either in the name and on behalf of such Missouri Trustee or additional or separate or co-trustee, or any of such trustees jointly, to take any and all action and exercise any and all rights or powers whether or not conferred upon the Trustee alone, or such Missouri Trustee or such additional or separate or co-trustee alone, or upon any of such trustees jointly, by any of the provisions of this Indenture or of the instrument or instruments under which such Missouri Trustee or such additional or separate or co-trustee was appointed, but subject to the duties hereby imposed upon such Missouri Trustee or such additional or separate or co-trustee, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all and singular the acts and things lawfully done by the Trustee or any substitute by virtue of this power of attorney.”

SECTION 4. Section 161 of Article Sixteen of the Original Indenture, as heretofore amended, is further amended by deleting the first sentence of said section and substituting a new first sentence in lieu thereof as follows:

“Any notice to or demand upon the Trustee or the Missouri Trustee may be served or presented, and such demand may be made, at the principal office of the Trustee or the Missouri Trustee, as the case may be.”

ARTICLE TWO

Miscellaneous Provisions

SECTION 1. The Original Indenture, as amended and supplemented by all indentures supplemental thereto including the First Supplemental Indenture, the Supplemental Indenture dated as of December 1, 1950, the Supplemental Indenture dated as of November 1, 1958, and the Supplemental Indenture dated as of April 1, 1959, and as further supplemented and amended by this Seventh Supplemental Indenture, are hereby ratified

and confirmed, and shall be read, taken and construed as one and the same instrument. Neither the execution of this Seventh Supplemental Indenture nor anything herein contained shall be construed to impair the lien of the Original Indenture, as amended, on any of the property subject thereto, and such lien shall remain in full force and effect as security for all Bonds now outstanding or hereafter issued under the Indenture. All terms defined in the Original Indenture, as amended, shall, for all purposes of this Seventh Supplemental Indenture, have the meaning specified in the Original Indenture, as amended, unless the text otherwise requires.

SECTION 2. The Trustees accept the trusts created by this Seventh Supplemental Indenture upon the terms and conditions hereof, and agree to perform such trusts upon the terms and conditions in the Original Indenture, as amended, and as amended and supplemented in this Seventh Supplemental Indenture. The Trustees shall not be responsible in any manner whatsoever for the recitals herein or in the Bonds or in the appurtenant coupons contained (save only the Trustee's responsibility for its authentication on the Bonds), all of which are made by the Company solely; nor shall the Trustees be responsible for or in respect of the validity or sufficiency of this Seventh Supplemental Indenture or the execution thereof by the Company. In general, each and every term and condition contained in Article Sixteen of the Original Indenture, as heretofore amended, shall apply to this Seventh Supplemental Indenture with the same force and effect as if the same were herein set forth in full, with such omissions, variations and modifications thereof as may be appropriate to make the same conform to this Seventh Supplemental Indenture.

SECTION 3. This Seventh Supplemental Indenture may be executed in any number of counterparts and all such counterparts, executed and delivered each as an original, shall together constitute but one and the same instrument.

SECTION 4. The Company at the time it executed, as mortgagor or grantor, the Original Indenture and each of the indentures supplemental thereto, and further at the time it executed this Seventh Supplemental Indenture, had been, was and still is carrying on the business of and operating a gas pipeline system.
