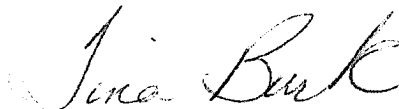

***POWTS Components Specifications:* 1750 gal. Septic Tank & 1200 sq. ft. Sand Filter System**

General Conditions:

1. System must be constructed in conformance with attached system layout, profiles, and cross-sections.
2. Structures must be constructed in conformance with 567 IAC Chapter 69 and the Madison County Environmental Health Regulations.
3. Permit shall be null and void if system is not constructed within one year of permit issuance. The Environmental Health Officer must approve any request for extension of permit.
4. The Environmental Health Officer must approve any design modifications to the permitted system prior to construction.
5. Once constructed, all system components must be uncovered for inspection and the system must be approved before it can be put into operation. Notice for inspection must be received with 24 hours in advance (8 a.m. through 4:30 p.m., Monday - Friday). If weather necessitates the need to cover the system components, then the system owner or contractor must notify and follow the procedures given by the Environmental Health Officer.

***Special Conditions:* All fees, maintenance, testing, & construction shall be in accordance with Engineer, Manufacturer, County, & State regulations.
At least a 24-hour notice for inspections.**
