Town Of Brooklyn

May 29th, 1855

Survey of the Town plot of Brooklyn made May 29, 1855 for John H. Guiberson on the south east quarter of section fourteen, Town. Seventy four, Range twenty seven west of the fifth principal meridian, Iowa. Beginning at the north west corner of the south east $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 14 in T. 174 R. 27 N. thence south 30.40 chains, east 16.75 chains, north 15.75 chains, E. 3.15 chains, north 14.58 chains, west 17.90 chains to place of beginning. The above named town is laid out in blocks seventeen rods square each block is divided in eight lots each lot is one hundred and thirty two feet east and west and sixty six feet north and south. There is two alleys sixteen and one half feet wide through each block which cross each other at right angles in the center of each block. The blocks are numbered from north west corner south to four five east of four then north to eight east of one then nine east of six south to eleven twelve south of five as shown on the plot. The lots number from north west corner of block south to four five east of four north to eight east of one as shown on the plot. The streets are all sixty six feet wide and cross each other at right angles running parallel with the section lines of the above named section. The streets are named as follows beginning at north side of plot first North Str. second Taylor Str. third Franklin Str. fourth Lafayette Str. fifth Madison Str. sixth South Str. beginning at west side of plot first West Str. second Washington Str. third Jackson Str. fourth Monroe Str. as shown on the plot. Out lots is numbered from north west corner east to four five south of four six west of five seven south of six eight east of seven nine in the south west corner of town plot as shown on plot. There is a stone at south west corner of block no. 2 north west of B 4 south west of B 6 south west of B 5 north east of B 8 and south west of out lot no. 7 as shown on the plot. field notes of out lots are as follows out lot no. 1 (N 3.15 E 4.25 S 3.14 W 4.25) No. 2 (N 3.14 E 4.25 S 3.12 W 4.25) No. 3 (N 3.12 E 4.25 S 3.09 W 4.25) No. 4 (N 3.09 E 3.15 S 3.08 W 3.15) No. 5 (N 4.25 E 3.15 S 4.25 W 3.15) No. 6 (N 4.25 E 4.25 S 4.25 W 4.25) No. 7 (N 4.25 E 4.25 S 4.25 W 4.25) No. 8 (N 4.25 E 3.15 S 4.25 W 3.15) out lot No. 9 (N 5.25 E 5.25 S 5.25 W 5.25) each out lot has the number of acres shown on the plot.

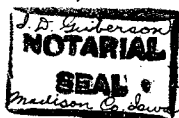
