Graves One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) of Lot No. Two Hundred Thirty-two (232) in the North Addition to Rock City Cemetery of Winterset, Iowa, a plat of which is recorded on pages forty-six (46) and forty-seven (47) of town plat record No. one (1) in the office of the County Recorder of Madison County, Iowa.

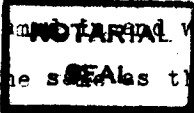
And the said Margaret M. Schoenenberger hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
