We, the undersigned Trustees of Douglas Township, Madison County, Iowa, acting as Fence Viewers at the request of F. D. Carey met on the 15th day of October, A. D. 1924 at the southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 76, North, Range 28, West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, for the purpose of establishing the division fence between the East and West Half of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 22.

We respectfully report that we established the division of fence as follows, to-wit: F. M. Peed shall maintain fence commencing at the northwest corner of the North East Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22 extending south 40 rods; the fence extending south 40 rods from this point shall be maintained by F. D. and D. L. Carey, excepting one flood gate, which flood gate shall be built by both parties and maintained by both parties alternate years, the said F. M. Peed beginning with the year 1925. From this point extending south 89 feet the fence shall be maintained by F. M. Peed and W. S. McDonald alternate years, the said F. M. Peed beginning with the year 1925. Thence South 34 rods and nine feet, the fence shall be maintained by W. S. McDonald, and the remaining 40 rods shall be maintained by F. M. Peed.

We further report that the Board assessed costs in the sum of Seven (\$7.00) Dollars against F. D. and D. L. Carey, onehalf of said amount to be paid by F. M. Peed, to F. D. and D. L. Carey.
