WHEREAS, on the 21st day of June A. D. 1928, J. E. Hamilton made request to us, the fence viewers of said Scott Township that A. M. Richmond refused and neglected to repair or rebuild his portion of the partition fence on the line between their said premises to-wit: The West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) and the East Quarter ($E\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Seventy-five (75) North, Range Twenty-seven (27), which is owned by A. M. Richmond, and the East Half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Seventy-five (75) North, Range Twenty-seven (27), J. Madison County, Iowa, which is owned by J. E. Hamilton.

And we hereby certify from the 21st day of June A. D. 1928 we caused notice in writing to be served on the said A. M. Richmond, that on the 2nd day of July 1928, at 10:00 o'clock A. M. we would meet at the said line and consider the matter of said complaint and make such order as might be right in the premises; and now, having met at the time and place named in said notice, and having examined said partition fence and heard the statements of the parties in reference thereto, we find that A. M. Richmond's portion of said fence is as follows: That part of said fence commencing at the Walnut Tree in the fence line and running North to the North End thereof about 140 rods more or less and that the said J. E. Hamilton's portion of said fence is as follows: Commencing at the said Walnut Tree on said fence line and running South to the said South End of said fence line in all about 100 rods more or less. It is further found by the said Fence Viewers that the said A. M. Richmond is to rebuild a portion of his part of said partition fence to-wit:- Commencing at said Walnut Tree and running North 40 rods, said portion to be rebuilt with new woven wire with six inch stays and not less than 26 inches high with three strands of barbed wire above. It is further found that the said J. E. Hamilton is to rebuild all his portion of said fence as above set out with new six inch stay woven wire not less than 26 inches high with three strands
