COPY OF MINUTES

The trustees of Monroe Township Madison County met on Oct 3rd 1949 as fence viewers on the land of H. A. Bierma and J Earl Galloway.

The dispute being division of fence between the N.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec 24 owned by J Earl Galloway and the S.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec 24 owned by H.A. and Gladys Bierma.

The trustees decided that starting at the west end of the fence between the two described pieces of land and continuing east for 425 feet to a large burr oak stump in the fence line should belong to J Earl Galloway.

and beginning at a point 425 feet east of west end of said fence line and continuing to east end of fence line between two said pieces of land should belong to H. A. and Gladys Bierma.

That a new fence be built by both parties consisting of woven wire of not less than 26 inches high with three barb wires on top. fence to be completed within 30 days. That J Earl Galloway have the privilege of removing the fence which he had erected on east end of said fence line

ORDER OF LEE TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES ON PRITCHARD-DICKEY PARTITION FENCE

The Board of Trustees of Lee Township, Madison County, Iowa, having met on the premises owned by Jerry Pritchard and George Dickey, Sr., located in Section Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18) of Lee Township, Madison County, Iowa on February 2, 1950, at one-thirty (1:30) P.M., notice of said meeting having been given to both parties, and said Trustees acting as fence viewers under the provisions of Chapter 113 of the 1946 Code of Iowa, and having viewed the partition fence, being the North-South Partition Fence located between the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Seventeen (17), and the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section Eighteen (18), in Lee Township, for the purpose of ascertaining whether or not said partition fence was a lawful hog-tight fence, and said Trustees hereby make the following order, to-wit:

Said partition fence is divided as follows: To Jerry Pritchard, the North Half (N 1/2), or North 40 rods, of said partition fence; To

George Dickey, Sr., the South Half (S½), or South 40 rods of said partition fence.

The Trustees further having found that the North Half (N½) of said partition fence, belonging to Jerry Pritchard, is a lawful hog-tight fence, in state of good repair, and having found that the South Half (S½), or South 40 rods of said partition fence is not a lawful hog-tight fence, it is hereby ordered by said Trustees that George Dickey, Sr. shall immediately make said partition fence hog-tight, said construction to be completed on or before May 1, 1950.

Trustees retain jurisdiction hereof, for the purpose of viewing said fence on May 1, 1950, and making such further orders as may be required under the circumstances.

The costs of the proceedings and the fees of the Trustees herein will be fixed on May 1, 1950, in an amount to be determined at said time. Said costs will be assessed against George Dickey, Sr.

All of which is ordered and entered of record by the Township Trustees of Lee Township, Madison County, Iowa.
