AGREEMENT OF OWNERS OF FARMS AS TO PARTITION FENCES

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this first day of August, 1946, between RAY ROBINSON AND MINNIE E. ROBINSON, husband and wife, as owners of an eight (8) acre tract of land located in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section One (1), Township Seventy-five (75) North Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the fifth P.M., Iowa, and MARGARET ROTZLER as the owner of 53.2 acres in the West Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section One (1), Township Seventy-five (75) North, Range

Twenty-eight (28) West of the Fifth P.M., Iowa:

WITNESSETH: That in consideration of the premises and the maintenance of the partition fence between their said lands the said parties hereby agree as follows:

That the said Ray Robinson and Minnie Robinson shall build, repair and maintain that part of said partition fence consisting of thirty-two (32) rods running East and West on the South side of the eight (8) acre tract located in Section One (1), Township Seventy-five (75) North, Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the Fifth P.M., Iowa, but the material and labor used in erecting the West six (6) rods of said Thirty-two (32) rods shall be paid for by Margaret Rotzler.

That the said Margaret Rotzler shall build, repair and maintain that part of said partition fence lying on the West side of the South four (4) acres of eight (8) acre tract owned by Ray Robinson and Minnie E. Robinson being twenty (20) rods North and South.

That both parts of said partition fence shall be so built, repaired and maintained so as to constitute a legal fence under the laws of the State of Iowa and that in case they shall fail to agree as to the same they will abide by the determination of the Fence Viewers of the Township of Lincoln in said County and State.
