It is further ordered by the undersigned fence-viewers that each of said owners shall immediately make said Partition Fence awarded to each of them a lawful fence and upon either of said parties making and erecting a tight fence, then the other party shall do so.

The costs of the proceedings for the division of said fence in the total sum of \$25.00 will hereby be assessed, one-half (½) to Arthur Marks and one-half (½) to Frank and Olive Wilson.

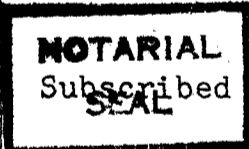

ORDER OF TRUSTEES ON DIVISION OF PARTITION
FENCE BETWEEN JAMES C. BENSON AND CECIL C. CLIFTON

The Board of Township Trustees of Douglas and Madison Townships meeting under the provisions of Code Section 113.14 of the 1946 Code of Iowa, met on the premises owned by James C. Benson and Cecil C. Clifton on the 18th day of November, A. D. 1947 at 10:00 o'clock A. M., after having served notice on Cecil C. Clifton and James C. Benson, respectively, the owners of the tracts of land located in Section Thirty-three (33) in Madison Township, Madison County, Iowa, and Section Four (4) of Douglas Township, Madison County, Iowa, and said Board of Trustees acting as fence-viewers under the provisions of Code Chapter 113 of the 1946 Code of Iowa

after viewing the partition fence in question, hereby make the following division of said partition fence.

To Cecil C. Clifton, that part of the North-South Partition Fence between the South Half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) and the South Half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-three (33), Madison Township, Madison County, Iowa, and that part of the North-South Partition Fence between the North Half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) and the North Half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Four (4), Douglas Township, Madison County, Iowa, commencing at the South end thereof and continuing North Six Hundred Seventy-six feet (676) and commencing at the North end of said Partition Fence and running thence South Nine Hundred Thirty-two feet (932). It is further ordered that end posts to be set by Cecil C. Clifton shall be set far enough back to allow James C. Benson sufficient room for a good anchor post to hold floodgate.

To James C. Benson that part of the above described Partition Fence located between the North and South ends thereof assigned to Cecil C. Clifton, commencing at a point on said Partition Fence Six Hundred Seventy-five feet (675) from the South end thereof and running North to a point on said Partition Fence line located Nine Hundred Thirty-two feet (932) South of the North end thereof. James C. Benson is further ordered to build and maintain any and all proper floodgates located on said portion of Partition Fence, said floodgates not to be attached to the end posts set in by Cecil C. Clifton.

It is further ordered that Cecil C. Clifton is to close the space between his anchor post and the floodgate anchor posts set in by James C. Benson.

It is further ordered by the Undersigned Fence-viewers that each of said owners shall immediately make said Partition Fence awarded to each of them the lawful fence, and upon either of said parties making and erecting a tight fence, then the other party shall likewise do so.

The cost of the proceedings for the division of said fence in the total sum of Thirty-one Dollars and Forty-five Cents (\$31.45) is hereby assessed to James C. Benson and said Fence-viewers hereby acknowledge receipt of payment thereof from the said James C. Benson.

All of which is hereby ordered and entered of record.

COPY OF MINUTES
Monroe Township Madison County Iowa

This is to Certify that on April the tenth 1948 the trustees of Monroe township met on the premises of land owned by E. B. Weeks and Wilbur E Smith described as follows.

The east one half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the South east one fourth ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West One fourth ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Sec 9 Monroe township possessed by E. B. Weeks. And the West One half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the South east One fourth ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of the south West One fourth ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of sec 9. Monroe township, possessed by Wilbur E Smith.

That said Meeting was for the purpose of establishing a division of the fence line seperating above described pieces of land.

That said Meeting was by the authority granted under section 113.3 Code of 1946. - State of Iowa.

That Written Notice was given E. B. Weeks and Wilbur E. Smith as required by law.

That division of fence was established as follows, beginning at the road line along south side of said land to a point Four hundred fifty three and $\frac{1}{2}$ ft North of said road line the fence shall belong to Wilbur E Smith.

beginning at a point four hundred fifty three and $\frac{1}{2}$ ft North of said road line to a point Nine hundred seven ft North of said road line shall belong to E. B. Weeks

beginning at a point Nine hundred seven ft North of said road line to the top of the North bank of Clanton Creek shall belong to Wilbur E Smith.

from the top of the North bank of Clanton Creek to the North line of above described land shall belong to E. B. Weeks

That Wilbur E Smith shall have the right to fasten his fence to the End post located Nine hundred seven ft North of said road line.
