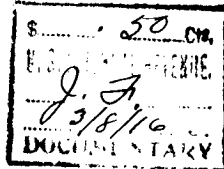
Know all men by these presents: That We, Jacob Foreman and Maude Foreman, Husband and wife, of Madison County, and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred DOLLARS *Truro Savings Bank of Madison County, State of Iowa as hereby sold & conveyed into* in hand paid by Truro Savings Bank and to their heirs and assigns, the following described premises, situated in Madison County, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Lot Eight (8) Block Two (2) Hull's Addition to Truro, Iowa (formally called Ego Ia.)

And we do hereby covenant with the said Truro Savings Bank that we lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free from incumbrance; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same; and we do hereby covenant to Warrant and Defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. And the granters aforesaid hereby relinquish all contingent rights, including dower and homestead, which they have in and to the said described premises.
