And we do hereby covenant with the said Mary A.Creger that——lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free from incumbrance; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same; and we do hereby covenant to Warrant and Defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
