Know all men by these presents: That we Avo L. Bowen and husband Elmer M. Bowen,

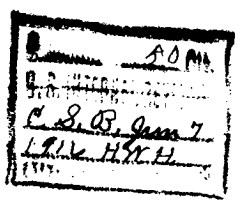
