Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4), in Block numbered Two (2), of the original town of Barney, Iowa, being a tract 264 feet East and West, by 132 feet North and South.

And the grantor herein covenant with the grantee that they have not sold or disposed of the interest in said premises that they acquired by descent as an heir of Charles Palmer, decedent, and they have placed no incumbrance on said property.
