Ap--15th 1856 Survey of Benjamin Linzey Addition to the town of Winterset, Madison County, Iowa said Addition is bounded as follows beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section one Township Seventy-five N. Range Twenty-eight W. thence West nine chains and sixty six and one half links thence N. twelve chains Forty one links East 9,66 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains South 12,41 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains Said Addition is divided into nine lots and one block the lots number from N.W. corner South and North to nine as shown on plat Block one is divided into twelve lots which are numbered from N. east corner South and North as shown on plat all the lots in block one is one hundred and fourteen feet and five inches east and west and sixty six feet North and South Oak street extends North and South Elm street extends N, S, and each is sixty feet wide Short street extends East and West and is twenty four feet wide the length of each line of the Range lots is in links marked on the plat.
