KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the Incorporated town of Earlham, Madison County, Iowa, by R.G.Hoskins, Mayor, and W.J.Price, Recorder, of said Incorporation, of the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar, in hand paid by S.C.Moreland, of the County, of Madison, and State of Iowa, do hereby QUIT CLAIM unto the said S.C.Moreland, all our right, title and interest in and to the following described premises situated in the Town of Earlham, Madison County, State of Iowa, to-wit: The land here to before dedicated to the public for public use and known as the alley in Block Eight (8) in the Original Town of Earlham, Iowa, as shown by the Plat of said Original Town of Earlham, Iowa, being bounded on the North by Main Street, on the East by Lot One (1) Block Eight (8) of Original Town of Earlham, Iowa, on the South by right of way of the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific Railway Company, on the West by Lot Three (3), Block Eight (8) of Original Town of Earlham, Iowa; This Deed is made by authority of a certain Ordinance, adopted by the Incorporated Town of Earlham, Iowa, on July 8th, 1901, authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of said town, to convey said alley. This Deed is made to correct error in certain deeds made hereto before as follows to-wit: One deed dated Jan 31-1902, and filed for Record February 1st, 1902, and Recorded in Madison County, Iowa, Town Lot Deed Record No 13, page 26, the other deed was dated July 21st, 1917, Ack, July 24th, 1917, and filed for record July 25th, 1917, and Recorded in Madison County Iowa, Deed Record No 61 and recorded on page 254.
