This Indenture, Made and executed this 19th day of August A.D. 1919, by and between Evening Star Lodge No. 43, A.F. & A.M., of Winterset, Iowa, of the first part, and Lucile D. Hake of Worland, Wyo., of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and the undivided - one-half interest in and to the wall hereinafter mentioned by second party, by deed dated June 12th A.D. 1919, has bargained and sold, and by these

presents do grant, bargain, sell and forever QUIT CLAIM unto the said party of the second part, her heirs, executors and assigns all our interest claim or demand in and to the following described property, situated in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The undivided one-half interest in and to the brick wall on the South side of the brick building situated on the North Two-Thirds (2/3) of Lot Five (5) in Block Seventeen (17) of the Original Town of Winterset, Iowa.

The intention of this conveyance and of the conveyance from Lucile D. Hake mentioned above is that the said Evening Star Lodge No. 43, A.F. & A.M. and the said Lucile D. Hake shall each own the undivided one-half interest in and to the aforesaid brick wall.

This conveyance is made pursuant to a resolution passed at the regular meeting of Evening Star Lodge No. 43, A.F. & A.M., of Winterset, Iowa, held on July 4th, 1919.
