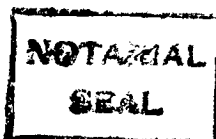
Lot Number Eight (8) in Block Number One (1) in Laughridge and Cassidays Addition to Winterset, Iowa.

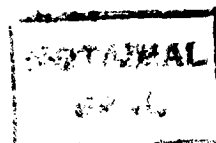

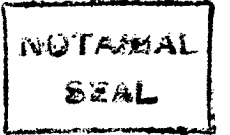

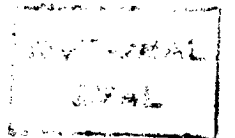
