KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That The Church of Christ of Winterset, Iowa of the County of Madison and State of Iowa for the consideration of the sum of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars hereby convey to Laura E.Rehard, of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, the following described real estate, situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit;

The South Ninety two (92) feet of Lots Three and Four (3 & 4) in Block One (1) of the Original Town of Winterset, Iowa.

And we hereby covenant with the said Laura E.Rehard that we hold said premises by good and perfect title; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same;; that they are free and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to Warrant and Defend the title to the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

This deed is executed pursuant to a resolution passed by a majority vote of all members of the Church of Christ of Winterset, Iowa, present at a regular called meeting thereof held on September 5th, 1920, at which time the Trustees of said Church were authorized and directed to execute a deed conveying said property to Laura E.Rehard.
