 paid by H.F.Reed of Madison County, State of Iowa, do hereby Sell and Convey unto the
 said H.F.Reed, the following described premises, situated in the county of Madison,
 and State of Iowa ,to-wit: Lots Three (3) and Four (4) of Block One (1) of the addi-
 tional lots to the Original plat of St Charles, Iowa; known as Hartman & Young's
 Addition to St Charles, Iowa.

The purpose of this deed is to correct any error that might have been made in a
 deed made to F.F.Jones and Minnie Jones on February 12th, 1909, and recorded in Town
 Lot Deed Record 16 -Page 219 thereof, which deed was signed by Louisa Johnston and
 Agnes Hattel as Parsonage Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church of St Charles,
 Iowa. And we covenant to Warrant and Defend the said premises against the lawful
 claims of all persons whomsoever claiming by, through or under us.
