Know all Men by these Presents: That we, C.M. Wallace and Mary H. Wallace, his wife, of Macksburg, Ia., do hereby certify that we are the sole owners of Lots 4 and 5 in Block 4 of Barker's Second Addition to Macksburg, Madison County, Iowa, and that we hereby dedicate to the Public, for use as an Alley, the following land, to-witt:

Beginning at a point 10 feet east of the Southwest corner of Lot 5, Block 4, Barker's Second Addition to said Macksburg, Ia., and running east to the east line of said Lot 5, thence North 10 feet, thence West 97 feet, thence Northwest on an angle of 45 degrees to the east line of the alley running north and south through the said Block 4, thence south to the place of beginning.

The said Mary H. Wallace, wife of the said C.M. Wallace, hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises. In Witness Whereof, we have hereunto set our hands this 10th day of Feb. A.D., 1916.
