The South Half (1/2) of the Northwest Quarter (1/4) except cemetery site of one-half (1/2) acre off the East side of the South eleven (11) acres of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of said Northwest Quarter (1/4); The Southwest Quarter (1/4), and the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Two (2); The Northwest Quarter (1/4) and the West Half (1/2) of the Northeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Eleven (11); All in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.
