Whereas, Levi Gantz of Washington County Pennsylvania has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Chariton whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Levi Gantz

according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

The South West fractional quarter of Section thirty in Township Seventy-five North of Range Twenty nine West in the District of Lands subject to Sale at Chariton, Iowa containing One Hundred and Forty nine acres and seventy eight hundredths of an acre

According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Levi Gantz

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said

Levi Gantz and to his heirs the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Levi Gantz and to his heirs and assigns forever.
