Whereas, William Lindsey of Guernsey County, Ohio deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Hles Moines whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Lindsey

according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North half of Section Seventeen, in Township Seventy-six North of Range twenty-nine West, in the District of Lands Subject to sale at Fort Hles Moines, Iowa, containing three hundred and twenty acres.

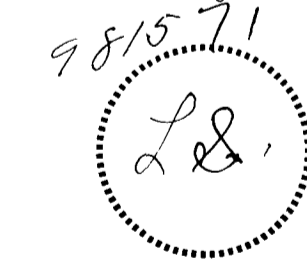
According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said William Lindsey

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said

William Lindsey and to his heirs the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said William Lindsey and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I Franklin Pierce President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the second day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six and of the Independence of the United States the eightieth

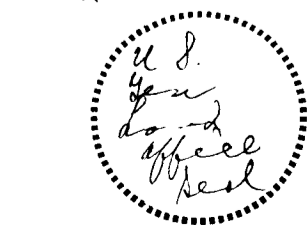
