Certificate No. 4465 Whereas, John M. Laughlin, of Madison County, Iowa has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Hes Moines whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John M. Laughlin

according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South half of the North East quarter, and the North half of the South East quarter of Section thirty-five in Township seventy-seven North, of Range twenty six West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Hes Moines, Iowa containing one hundred and fifty acres.

According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said John M. Laughlin

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John M. Laughlin and to his heirs the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said John M. Laughlin and to his heirs and assigns forever.
