According to the official plot of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Ralph Bowe

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said

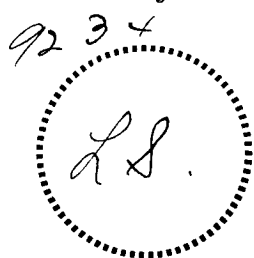
Ralph Bowe and to his heirs the said tract above described;
