The South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Seventeen in Township Seventy seven North, of Range Twenty eight West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Des Moines, Iowa containing forty acres.

According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Josiah H. Barnett

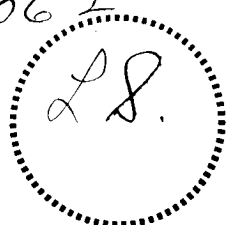

Josiah H. Barnett and to his heirs the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Josiah H. Barnett and to his heirs and assigns forever.

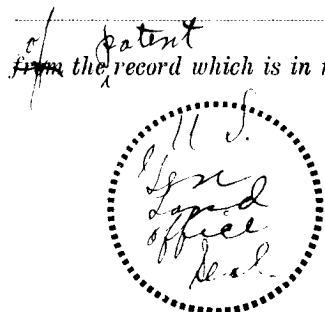
