whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Joseph J. Hutchings according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

The West half of the north west quarter of Section twelve, in Township seventy five of Range twenty nine, and the north east quarter of the South west quarter of Section seven, in Township seventy five, north of Range twenty eight, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Churilton, Iowa, containing one hundred and twenty acres

According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Joseph J. Hutchings

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said

Joseph J. Hutchings and to his heirs the said tract above described;

to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Joseph J. Hutchings and to his heirs and assigns forever.
