Whereas, Matthew M. McGee, of Monroe County, Iowa has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Des Moines whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Matthew M. McGee

according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the West fractional half of the South West quarter of Section thirty, in Township Seventy six, North, of Range Twenty eight West in the District of Lands, subject to sale at Fort Des Moines, Iowa, containing Fifty seven, acres and Eight hundredths of an acre.

According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Matthew M. McGee,

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Matthew M. McGee,

and to his heirs the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Matthew M. McGee and to his heirs and assigns forever.
