According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Isaac G. Houk

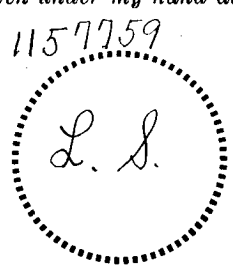

Houk and to his heirs the said tract above described;

to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Isaac G. Houk and to his heirs and assigns forever.
