according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for The South half of the South West quarter of section thirty six, and the south half of the South East quarter of section thirty five in Township seventy five North of Range twenty six West, in the district of lands subject to sale at Chariton Iowa containing one hundred and sixty acres.

According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tracts have been purchased by the said Sarah Burkett, Elizabeth Burkett, Polly Burkett and Rhoda F. Burkett

Burkett and to their heirs the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Sarah Burkett, Elizabeth Burkett Polly Burkett and Rhoda F. Burkett and to their heirs and assigns forever.
