The West half of the North West quarter of Section thirty-one in Township Seventy-five north of Range twenty-eight West in the District of Lands formerly subject to sale at Chariton now Fort Des Moines Iowa containing sixty four acres and ten hundredths of an acre.

According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Evan W. Evans

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Evan W. Evans and to his heirs the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Evan W. Evans and to his heirs and assigns forever.

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

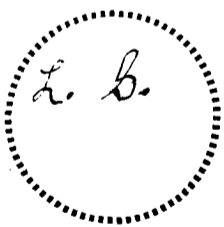

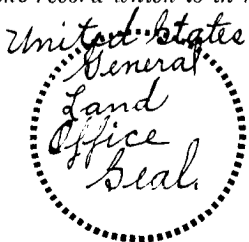
