Whereas, Hornel Reid of St Joseph County Indiana has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Des Moines whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Hornel Reid

according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for The North East fractional quarter of the North East quarter and the North half of the South West quarter of Section One in Township Twenty seven North of Range Twenty Eight West in the District of Land subject to sale at Fort Des Moines Iowa, containing One Hundred and Nineteen Acres and forty-five hundredths of an acre.

According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract share been purchased by the said Hornel Reid

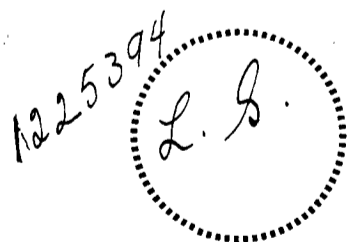
Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the general acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Hornel Reid and to his heirs the said tracts above described; to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Hornel Reid and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I Franklin Pierce President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
