WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 45867 for 80 acres, issued in favor of Gideon Taylor, Private in Captain Jackson's Company, Virginia Militia War of 1812

has been returned to the General Land Office, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North East Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section Twelve and South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section One in Township Seventy Six North of Range Twenty Seven West in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Fort Des Moines, Iowa, containing eighty acres,

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor-General which has been assigned to William Ferris

NOW, KNOW YE, That there is therefore, granted by the United States unto the said William Ferris

the tract of Land above described; to have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said William Ferris and to his heirs and assigns forever.
