WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States" Warrant No. 66956 for 40 acres, issued in favor of James Ford, Private in Captain Wellington's Company Massachusetts Militia, Mar. 1812 has been returned to the General Land Office, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the

NOW, KNOW YE, That there is therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Edward M. Greenway Jr the tract of Land above described; to have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Edward M. Greenway Jr and to his heirs and assigns forever.
