Whereas, Elijah Smith, of Madison County, Iowa has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Chariton whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Elijah Smith according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

The North East Quarter of the South East Quarter; The South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section seven; the South West Quarter of the North West Quarter; and the North West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section eight in Township seventy four North of Range twenty six, West in the District of Lands subject to sale at Chariton, Iowa, containing one hundred and sixty acres.

According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract have been purchased by the said Elijah Smith

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Elijah Smith and to his heirs the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Elijah Smith and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I Franklin Pierce President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
