the East half of Section Eight in Township Seventy seven, North of Range Twenty seven, West, in the District of lands subject to sale at Fort Des Moines, Iowa, containing three hundred and twenty acres.

According to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Joseph Hill Junior

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Joseph Hill Junior and to his heirs the said tract above described;

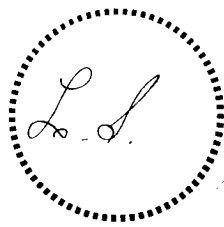
