To all to Whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 35,537 for 40 acres, issued in favor of Retilda Mansfield widow of William Mansfield, deceased, Private in Captain Kerple's company twenty sixth Regiment Maryland Militia, Mar 1812 has been returned to the General Land Office, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section twelve, in Township Seventy four North, of Range twenty seven West in the district of Land subject to sale at Ashton, Iowa, containing Forty acres

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor-General which has been assigned to Edward M. Greenway, Junior

NOW, KNOW YE, That there is therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Edward M. Greenway Junior the tract of Land above described; to have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Edward M. Greenway Junior, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
