WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 7312 for 80 acres, issued in favor of Robert Mc Clintock Private in Captain Williams Company Tennessee Militia Mar 1812

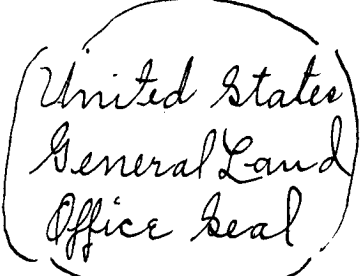
