WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 25518 for 80 acres, issued in favor of Stephen T. Hookey, Private in Captains Magagnos Holladays and Lacoeks Companies, Virginia Militia, War of 1812 has been returned to the General Land Office, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the
