To all to Whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No 23, 681 for 80 acres, issued in favor of Thomas Nichols Private in Captain Elson's Company First Regiment Virginia Militia War 1812 has been returned to the General Land Office, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South half of the South East Quarter of Section fourteen in Township Seventy Six North, of Range Twenty six West in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Des Moines Iowa containing Eighty Acres

According to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor-General which has been assigned to George Denison

NOW, KNOW YE, That there is therefore, granted by the United States unto the said George Denison

the tract of Land above described; to have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said George Denison and to his heirs and assigns forever.
