The North West quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty-seven in Township Seventy-six North, of Range Twenty-nine West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Des Moines, Iowa, containing forty acres

according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Joseph H. Gallaher

Now, KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said

Joseph H. Gallaher, and to his heirs, the said tract above described.

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Joseph H. Gallaher and to his heirs and assigns forever.
