North west quarter, of the South East quarter, and the North East quarter, of the South West quarter, of section twenty Seven, in Township Seventy five North, of Range twenty Seven West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Chariton Iowa Containing Eighty acres

according to the official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which has been assigned to Ralph Stout,

Now, KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Ralph Stout, the tract of land above described.

To have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Ralph Stout, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
