

Certification of Description of Lots Sec 8, Tp. 73, R. 27,
On March 4th, 1909, I made a Survey for J. C. Crawford for the purpose of record & transfer
in the N. W. 1/4 Sec. 8 above, said lots numbered on the accompanying plat from North to south & described as follows: (Lot No. 1) Beginning at the North 1/4 Sec. Corner of Section 8, thence with (46) forty six rods to a stake in this survey thence South eighty eight (88) rods to a point in Middle River, thence with (50) fifty rods to a stake in this survey, thence by two small staked trees, thence South 73° 53' East forty seven and eighty nine one hundred and one (101) rods to a stake in the Middle River, thence North twenty seven and one fourth (27 1/4) rods to a stake in the place of beginning (Lot No. 2) Beginning at a point twenty seven and one fourth (27 1/4) rods south of the North 1/4 Cor., Sec. 8 thence North 78° 53' west, forty seven and eighty nine one hundred and thirty four (134) rods to a point in the River described above, thence South twenty three and sixty five (23 1/2) rods to a stake in this survey thence East six (6) rods to a stake in this survey thence North 5° 54' East, twelve (12) rods to a stake in this survey, thence North 20° East eighty eight (88) rods to a point in the North edge of Middle River, thence East twenty nine (29) rods to a stake in the North edge of Middle River, thence North thirty one and thirty nine (31 3/4) rods to a stake in the place of beginning (Lot No. 3) Beginning at a point thirty one and thirty nine (31 3/4) rods south of the North 1/4 Cor., Sec. 8, above, thence with (134) rods to a stake in the Middle River, thence South 20° west, eighty eight (88) rods to a stake, thence South 5° 54' west, six (6) rods to a stake, thence South thirty one and thirty nine (31 3/4) rods to a stake, thence East forty (40) rods to a stake, thence North fifty nine (59) rods to a stake in the place of beginning, I hereby certify the foregoing survey and description to be correct as performed and described by me on the 4th of March, 1909.

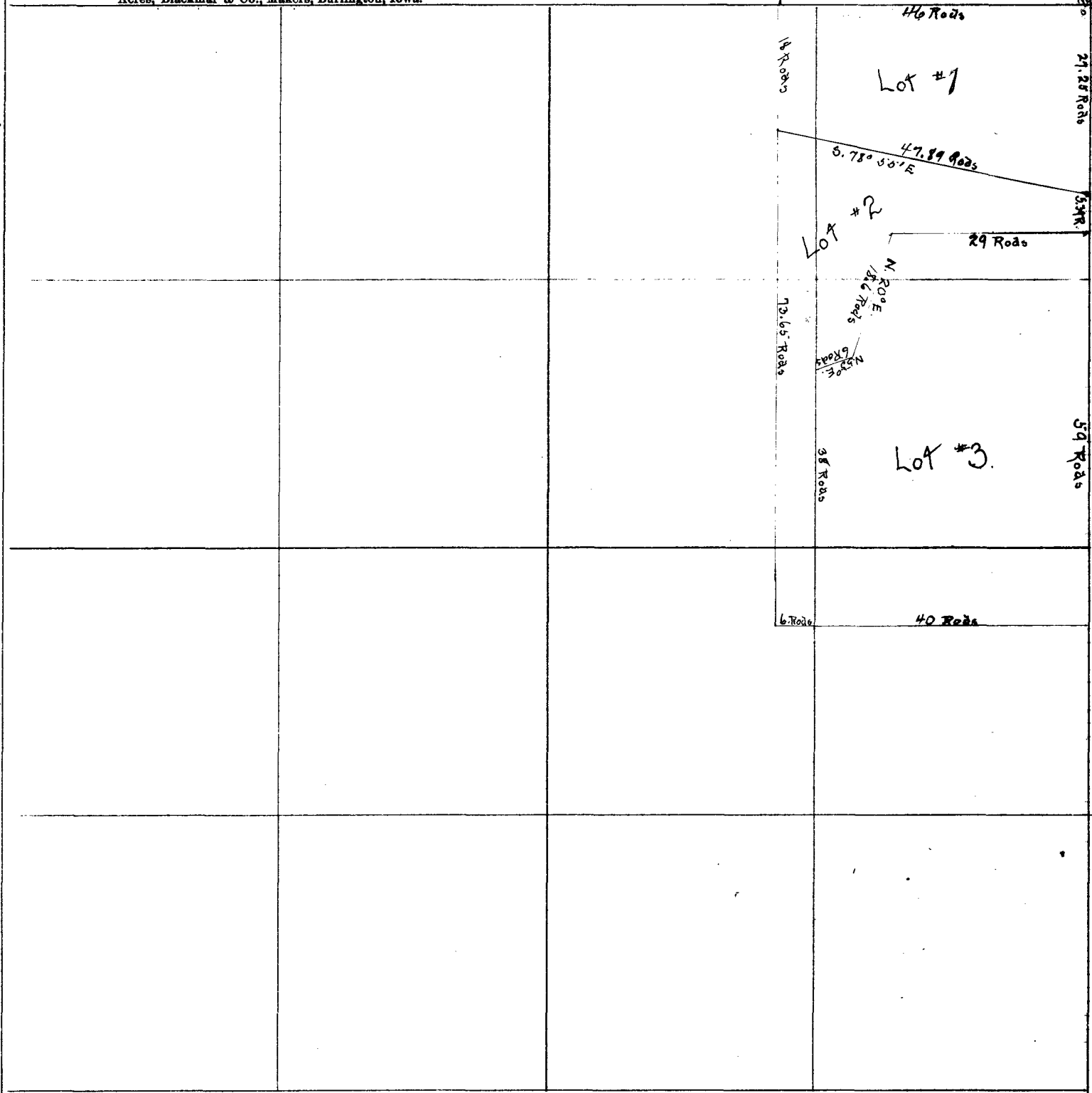
