State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars, in hand paid by P.N. Barker of Madison
County and State of Iowa, (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), does hereby sell and con-
vey unto the said P.N. Barker the premises hereinafter described, situate in the County of Madison
and State of Iowa, for the purpose, and upon the express condition that the same be used only as
a place of interment, and be subject to the general regulations made, or to be made, for the
government of the Moon Cemetery of the Township of Grand River, and in violation of said condi-
tions, or any of them, said premises shall revert to said Township. Said premises are, and are
described as lot numbered Sixty-nine of the Addition of 1877, to the Moon Cemetery of the Town-
ship of Grand River, a plat of which is recorded on page 314 of Book No. 22, Deed Records, in the
office of the County Recorder of Madison County, Iowa. And the said Township of Grand River
hereby covenants to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons
whomsoever. IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF the said Township of Grand River has hereunto caused these
